About the Danish Society on Thrombosis and Haemostasis (DSTH)

Knowledge of evaluation, diagnosis and treatment of patients with thrombosis is essential within many medical specialities. This interdisciplinary area has by tradition been managed by the specialities Clinical Chemistry and Internal Medicine in Denmark.

Since a common forum for physicians and other professionals on issues regarding thrombosis and haemostasis was warranted in Denmark, DSTH was established on 8 December 1993 and today the society has more than 500 members.

The Objects of the Society

In accordance with the regulations of the society the object of DSTH is to increase knowledge of thrombosis and haemostasis and to heighten the educational level on this issue among Danish physicians. These demands are met through scientific meetings, symposia, and seminars arranged by the DSTH. The society collaborates with various scientific societies and serves as an advisory body to the National Health Service of Denmark.

In 1994 DSTH was associated to the International Society on Thrombosis and Haemostasis (ISTH), and in 1995 DSTH was associated to The Danish Society on Internal Medicine.

Information

The DSTH Newsletters are released in five issues per year. The Newsletters summarise the activities of the society, and several reviews (most of them in Danish) per year are published on topics regarding thrombosis and haemostasis. On the homepage of DSTH it is possible to study slide kits and to read reviews in English and Danish. In the future, useful tools will be available from this homepage.
